Creamy, sweet, and buttery, Ice Cream Cake is decadent with rich notes of freshly-churned vanilla ice cream and earth. As you continue to smell the strain, toasted nut and some savory characteristics like salted butter and creamy Brie cheese begin to appear followed by soft hints of pine, citrus, and cookie dough. On the palate, this strain is creamy and rich, displaying soft vanilla notes followed by a hint of meringue.

Ice Cream Cake's rich profile complements an oaked Chardonnay's buttery and oaky notes. Because of the strain's vanilla, butter, and toasted nut characteristics, when it comes to this pairing, the butterier the Chardonnay, the better. Look for Mer Soleil Santa Lucia Highlands Reserve Chardonnay.
